ORDER:-

In the G.O. 2nd read above, the Government have enhanced the benefit of the scheme for providing financial assistance from Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand only) to Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) as marriage gift to the registered unmarried women workers and two daughters of the registered construction worker with the certain guidelines prescribed in the G.O. 1st read above under Rule 33 (L) of Andhra Pradesh Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Rules, 1999, read with Sec.22 of the Building & Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996.

2. In the letters 4th read above, the Secretary and Chief Executive Officer, Andhra Pradesh Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad has proposed to enhance the Marriage Gift amount from the existing Rs. 10,000/- to Rs. 20,000/- for unmarried registered women workers/two daughters of the registered construction workers under Scheme of Marriage Gift as resolved in the 16th Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Welfare Workers Board meeting Dated: 24.03.2017 with certain guidelines /norms. In the letter 5th read above, the Commissioner of Labour, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada has recommended the said proposal.

3. Under Section 22 of the Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Services) Act, 1996 empowers the Board constituted under the Act to provide welfare measures and facilities to the Building and Other Construction Workers registered as beneficiaries with the Board and it is required in accordance with Rule 33-L of Andhra Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment & Conditions of Service) Rules, 1999 that Government have to issue approval to such schemes.

4. After careful examination, the Government hereby accord approval for enhancement of the benefit under Marriage Gift Scheme from Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) to Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty thousand only) to provide financial Assistance for unmarried registered women workers/ two daughters of the registered construction workers with following guidelines/norms, under Rule – 33(L) of Andhra Pradesh Building & Other

Pradesh Building and Other Construction Workers (RE&CS) Act, 1996 in supersession of all earlier orders issued in the matter:

- (i) An amount of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) shall be paid as a Marriage Gift to the registered woman BOC Worker and two daughters of the registered BOC worker on the occasion of their marriage.
- (ii) The application for the benefit shall submit within 6 months from the date of performance of the marriage.
- (iii) The benefit shall be extended to the registered unmarried women workers/ two daughters of beneficiaries, who have completed the age of 18 years at the time of marriage.
- (iv) The claimant shall make either online claim in the official web portal of Andhra Pradesh Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board along with scanned copies of following documents or submit the physical application in the prescribed format along with the following documents:
 - 1.Copies of Aadhar card of bride and BOC Worker
 - 2.Age proof certificate
 3. Marriage Registration Certificate issued by the Registrar for marriages under the Andhra Pradesh Compulsory Marriage Registration Act, 2002/ Marriage certificate issued by the Waqf Boards/ Church/ Panchayat Secretary
 4. Wedding Invitation
 - 5.Marriage photos and
 6. Copy of the Bank Account Pass Book of Bride.
- (v) After necessary verification, the authorized official sanctions the scheme amount and the same shall be paid by way of direct transfer to the bank account of the Bride.

6. The Commissioner of Labour, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada and the Secretary & Chief Executive Officer, Andhra Pradesh Building & Other Construction Workers Welfare Board, Hyderabad shall take necessary action.
